Study programme

Within the standard period of study (two years/full time):

First academic year

- First term
 Module 1-6
 Study paper
 Written examination (module 2/3/5) on 16 April 2026
- Second term
 Module 7-12
 Study paper
 Oral examination (module 8/9/10) in Sept-Nov 2026

- Internship: Full time (six months), part time (accordingly longer)
- Master's thesis (2 + 6 months + 4 weeks)





Study paper § 11 (3) and § 19

- For modules 1, 4, 7, 11, 12, a study paper must be passed, for module 6 there will be a projekt work; the grade is the overall grade of the respective module.
- Submission of the study paper in due time, <u>normally</u> within four weeks (in accordance with the studyplan)
- Each study paper comprises a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 15 A4 pages.
- Language: English





Aim of study papers § 19 (1)

In study papers, the student should demonstrate that he/she can independently work on a limited topic of the module.

Present it in writing in a manner appropriate to the requirements of science (good scientific practice).





Repetition of study paper § 16 (1, 2)

- An examination with a grade of < 4.0 is deemed to have been passed. In case of failure, a new topic will be provided.
- Two repetitions are possible. If you fail three times, it leads to exmatriculation.

§ 16 (3)

 A module examination graded at least 'sufficient' cannot be repeated. It is therefore not possible to improve grades.





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Participation in written examination § 14 (4)

Prior attendance of the relevant modules
 2 and/or 3 and/or 5

Date:

Thursday, 16 April 2026, 1pm, Bonn

The exams for module 2, 3, 5 take place on the same day for organisational reasons





Written examination § 11 (3) and § 16 (1,3)

- 3-4 questions/tasks per module
- Examination time per module approx. 30 min
- Exam language: English
- Passed with at least 4.0 per module, 2 repetitions possible, only failed modules will be repeated
- Further information will be sent in advance via email





Written examination assessment

- 2 reviewers per question/task (calculation of mean value)
- All grades for a module are added together and the average is calculated:
- Two examples:

-	Question 1:	Grade 1.7	[or	2.0]
-	Question 2:	Grade 2.3	[or	5.0]
-	Question 3:	Grade 5.0	[or	5.0]
	average:	(9.0 / 3) 3.0	[or	4.0]





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Participation in oral examination § 14 (4)

Prior attendance of the relevant modules
 8 and/or 9 and/or 10

Oral examination § 11 (3) and § 16 (1, 3)

- Passed with at least 4.0 per module
- 2 repetitions possible
- Only failed modules will be repeated





Oral examination (September – November 2026)

- About 6 dates in advance to choose from
- The exams for module 8, 9, 10 take place on the same day for organisational reasons
- One examiner per module is present on each date
- Students come together in groups of 3
- 3 date requests from each group
- Exam time per module per student approx. 10 15 minutes
- Examination language: English





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- Second term
 Module 7-12
 Study paper
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- Internship: Full time (six months), part time (accordingly longer)
- Master's thesis (2 + 6 months + 4 weeks)





Internship

- Full time six months. Part time accordingly longer
 (e.g. 50% = 12 month). Apply independently and worldwide.
- Earliest start possible after participation in at least six of twelve modules and completion of the associated study paper
- Registration before start
- Submission of the internship report (5-15 A4 pages) within four weeks after completion. No grading.

OR

 Recognition of two years of work experience (prior to studying) as an internship. Application + submission of an report.

- First term
 Module 1-6
 Study paper
 Written examination (module 2/3/5) on 16 April 2026
- Second term
 Module 7-12
 Study paper
 Oral examination (module 8/9/10) in Sept-Nov 2026

- Internship: Full time (six months), part time (accordingly longer)
- Master's thesis (2 + 6 months + 4 weeks)





Master's thesis § 20

- Earliest start possible after participation in at least six of twelve modules and completion of the associated study paper
- Search for topic/avoid overlap of contents (contact MDRA office)
- Select supervisor (discuss and define topic)
- Appointment of the second supervisor (MDRA office)
- Topic reservation + registration/processing time + Extension of time (upon justified request)
- One repetition possible
- Text section: 30 up to 60 A4 pages. Language: English or German

Overall grade of the Master's examination

- Study papers, project work, written/oral examinations: 50%
- Master's thesis: 50%
- Internship: No grading.
